

Where to look for Damp and Seal breakdown in a Caravan



There are three types of mastic used in caravans,

- Acrylic compounds should last about 12 years,
- Oil based are more common and should last about 6 years,
 - silicone based sealants will last about 20 years

If you attempt to reseal your caravan yourself you must ensure that you remove *all* of the old mastic and clean *all* surfaces thoroughly.

Always Check your caravan out with a Damp Meter

Found some Damp, go to the best place to see how easy it is to repair at a fraction of the cost that a dealer will charge you.
