Performance

Straightforward design coupled with over 40 years' experience in this industry has produced a Caravan which provides a graceful exterior combined with a very practical and comfortable interior layout. With a low centre of gravity and a semi-streamlined shape, roadholding is excellent and manoeuvring simple.

Impervious to Weather Conditions

The resistance to penetration of damp into the vulnerable end walls is greatly increased by the shaping of the roof which is carried over the ends of the Caravan to form small eaves. The six



wide opening windows which light the spacious interior are mounted in heavily plated metal frames set in rubber. Aluminium wall panelling of the exterior is mounted on hardwood framing packed with a filling of spun glass; the interior walls of oak panelling hand polished and backed with insulated boarding complete the measures taken to eliminate condensation whilst providing a charming background to the luxurious interior. The insulated roof is made up of exterior sheeting of tempered board underneath cotton duck impregnated in white lead and finished with oil paint. Two ventilators above give a measure of ventilation without the necessity of opening windows and the incorporation of a skylight in the roof of the centre apartment adds to the spaciousness of the Caravan.



Accessories for Comfort Safety and Endurance

All three apartments are served by gas and electric lighting, and there is a handily placed electric power plug in the central lounge to which mains power is carried from the nearside external plug. Access to the locker which houses the gas storage cylinder is had from the outside of the Caravan, the compartment, being readily adaptable for use as a food storage cupboard, is adequately ventilated. The transformer, which steps down mains current to suit the voltage of the interior lighting, is also housed therein,

The KELVIN STAR is built on a chassis of welded and bolted channel steel, and suspension of road wheels on a straight square section axle is made through semi-elliptical 9-leaf springs. Automatic braking which can be manually set and four rigid jacks ensure stability when at rest. The patent Brockhouse coupling and retractable jockey wheel, which makes for easy manhandling, complete the chassis equipment.

An alternative to gas geyser and radiator is offered by the Pither's Anthracite Stove, which serves both to heat water and to provide a warming homely atmosphere in this mobile mansion. There is no extra cost entailed whatever your choice may be.
